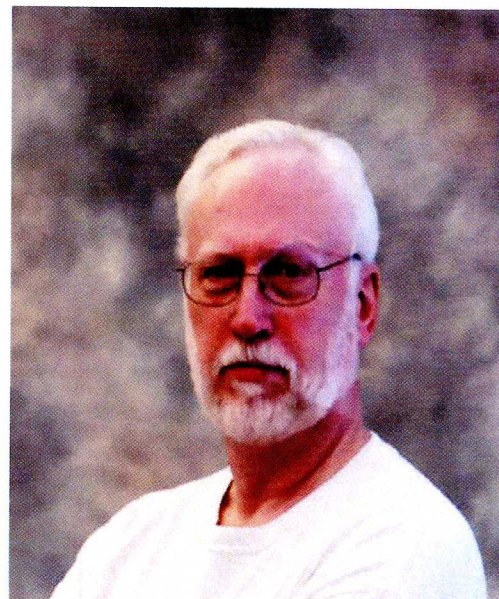


DENNIS PFEFFER

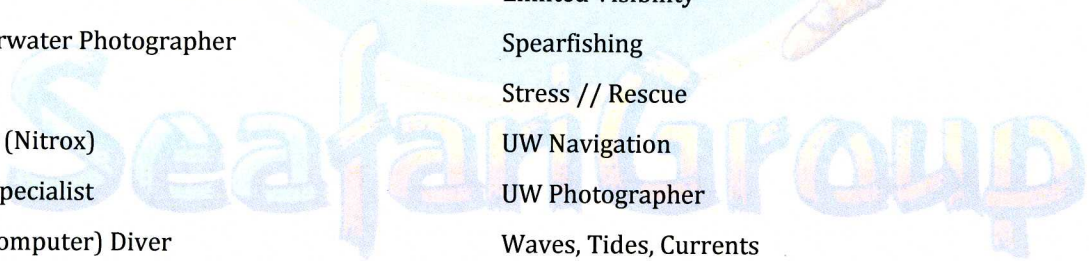
