

ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE

DESCRIPTION

The **ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE** consists of five (5) separate dives including a deep dive and an underwater navigation dive plus any three adventure dives based on available equipment and dive site location.

PREREQUISITES

Be certified as a PADI Open Water Diver or have a qualifying certification from another training organization. Minimum age is 15.

COURSE OUTLINE

Independent Study: Read the sections and complete the review questions for Deep and UW Navigator plus the three (3) elective sections in the *Adventures in Diving Manual*. View the *Adventures in Diving DVD*

Session I: Complete the navigation dive plus two adventure dives

Session II: Complete the deep dive plus the last adventure dive

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS*

Mask, Fins, Snorkel and Booties

BCD

Regulator w/ two second stages

UW Light/s

Slate

Gauges: pressure, depth, compass, timing device

Dive Table / Dive Computer

Dive knife/cutting device

Wetsuit – as needed for thermal protection

Specific equipment needed for elective dives

Tanks: one for each dive (5 dives)

(Tanks and weights are included)

(other required equipment may be rented at 50% off as needed)
