

Rescue Diver

DESCRIPTION

The **RESCUE DIVER COURSE** expands a diver's knowledge and experience beyond a purely recreational level. Rescue divers learn to look beyond themselves to consider the safety and well-being of other divers. Rescue training readies student divers to help prevent problems and, if necessary, manage dive emergencies using a variety of learned techniques.

PREREQUISITES

Be certified as a PADI Advanced Open Water Diver or have a qualifying certification from another training organization. Also, the student must have successfully completed a sanctioned course in CPR within the past two years (24 months). Proof of 20 or more logged dives documenting experience in deep diving and uw navigation. Minimum Age: 15

COURSE OUTLINE

Independent Study: Read all sections and complete all review questions from the PADI *Rescue Diver Manual*. View the *Rescue Diver DVD*.

Classroom & Pool Required

Session I: Cover manual, review questions & correct missed questions

Session II: Take final exam & review/ correct missed questions

Session III: Complete three (3) training dives (exercises 1-6) – Pool

Session IV: Complete two (2) training dives (exercises 7-12) – Open Water
